Creature from the Deep

Scientists find a strange new species of squid ¹⁾

(...) In the deepest, darkest cavities of the world's biggest oceans is a mysterious creature with large fins ²⁾ and 10 arms. Humans have only seen it eight times. Since 1988, the animal has been spotted in the Gulf of Mexico and the Atlantic, Indian and Pacific Oceans at depths ranging from 6,300 feet to 15,390 feet. That's almost three miles under the surface! The most recent sighting ³⁾ was last year, when researchers spotted a 17-foot-long creature more than two miles deep in the central Pacific.

Using special underwater vessels and cameras, scientists captured the monster on film. Now they are trying to determine exactly what it is. "I call it a mystery squid," says Michael Vecchione, who studies squids and octopods (...) with the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration in Washington, D.C. Last month, Vecchione and other scientists published their theories about the squid in the journal *Science*.

The creature, which ranges in length from 5 to 23 feet, is a new species of squid unlike any known species. Squids normally have eight arms plus two longer tentacles. The mystery squid has arms and tentacles that appear to be of about equal thickness and length. All 10 have "elbows" ⁴⁾ and at least some have suckers ⁵⁾.

Scientists hope to capture one of the creatures and examine it closely. "It seems that these are fairly common," says Vecchione. "That they have not been previously observed indicates how little is known about life in the deep ocean." Who knows what other unknown creatures await discovery there?

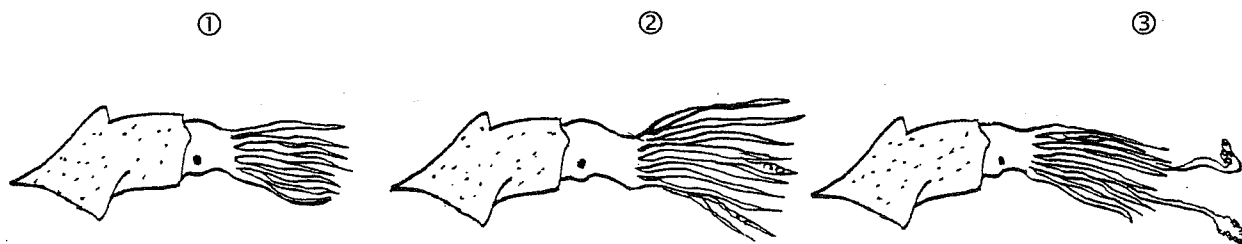
